March 12 – July 31, 2020

The 2020 Census:



- Counts everyone in the country — adults, kids, babies, seniors — everyone!
- Asks 9 questions every 10 years and takes 10 minutes to complete.
- Has **NO CITIZENSHIP QUESTION**.
- Is safe and confidential.
- Affects the number of Congress members that get to represent Pennsylvania.
- Provides data that influences where parks, schools, and supermarkets are built.
- Determines how \$800 billion in federal funding is spent on programs, like WIC, Medicare Part B, TANF, CHIP, and Section 8.
- Can provide Pennsylvania with \$26.8 billion a year, or **\$2,000 per person per year to support community programs**.

Fill out the 2020 Census online



- Beginning in March, every household will receive a notice in the mail from the U.S. Census Bureau (up to three times) with instructions on how to access and fill out the census questionnaire online.
- Census Day is April 1, 2020, the date the Bureau has historically counted everyone, but the census is available to complete from March 12 – July 31, 2020.
- You can respond anytime, anywhere, from any device. You can also mail your form or complete it over the phone.
- **The U.S. Census Bureau will only visit homes that do not respond to the census online.**
